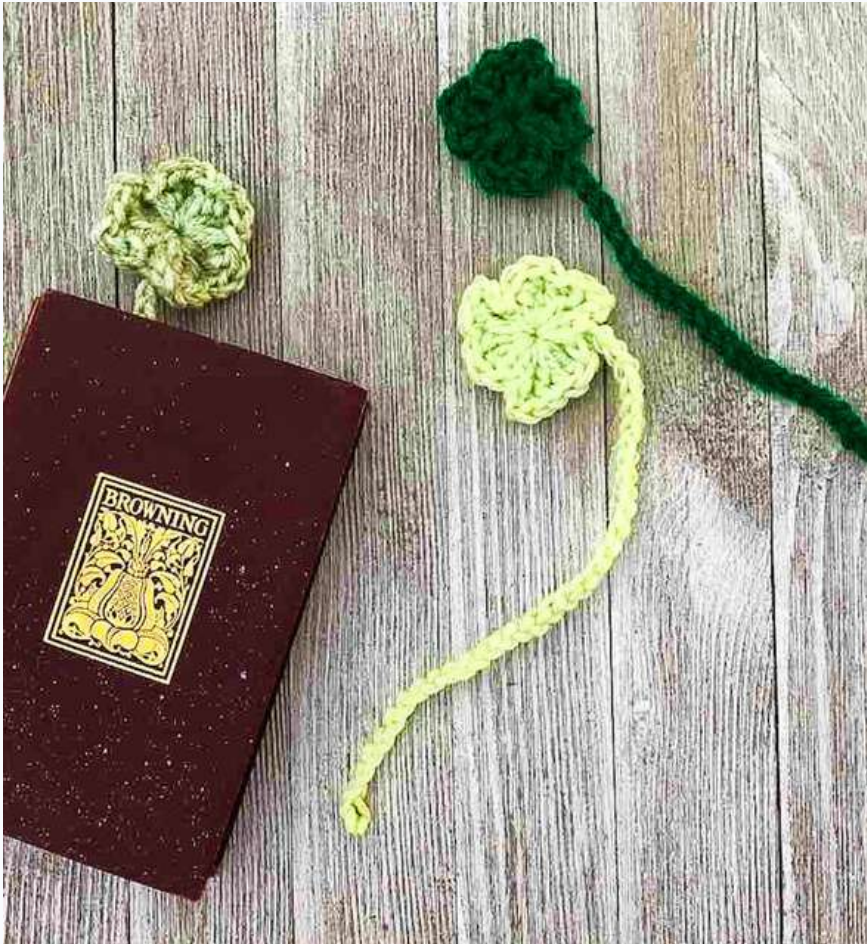
Crochet Pattern

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EASY SHAMROCK BOOKMARK

a b o u t

These little clover bookmarks are oh so easy and super beginner friendly!

They require only a few basic stitches and can be whipped up in 5-10 minutes flat. Make them with three leaves or four to add a little green to your St. Patrick's Day decor!

Gauge/Tension

12.5 stitches and 8 rows = 4 x 4 -
inches in double crochet using H/8
5.00mm hook in double crochet.

Recommended yarn

Red Heart Super Saver, medium 4
worsted weight, 100% acrylic,
198g/7oz, 364yds/333m per skein.

- Measuring tape

- Tapestry needle for weaving in ends
- Pom pom (optional)

Abbreviations

Finished Dimensions

**All measurements are approximate, measured flat pre-use, and are provided in inches.*

- 9 - inches from the top of the clover to the bottom of the stem.

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Additional Notes

Read all pattern notes, instructions, and other provided details carefully before starting the project to make sure you understand everything. It could save you hours & a lot of headaches!

- The gauge/tension is not critical for this pattern, however, if you want to be sure you meet the gauge for this pattern then make a swatch of each square that measures at least 10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4 inches using the stitch provided under the Gauge Section. If your swatch matches the gauge, then you are all set to start the project. If the gauge is wrong, you might need to change your crochet hook - increase your hook size if your stitches are smaller & decrease your hook size if your stitches are larger.
- All measurements given are unblocked and measured pre-wear and as fabric pieces may stretch during/after blocking, and wearing.
- Provided measurements are as exact as possible, but are given as approximates. This is because yarn variances, crochet tension & individual technique might give variations in the result, which changes from person to person.
- The leaf section of this pattern is worked in the round.
- The stem section of this pattern is worked flat in rows.
- Stitch counts are given in [] at the end of each round. If no stitch count is given, then the count is the same as the previous round.
- Care Instructions: Hand wash & lay flat to dry or follow instructions on the yarn label.

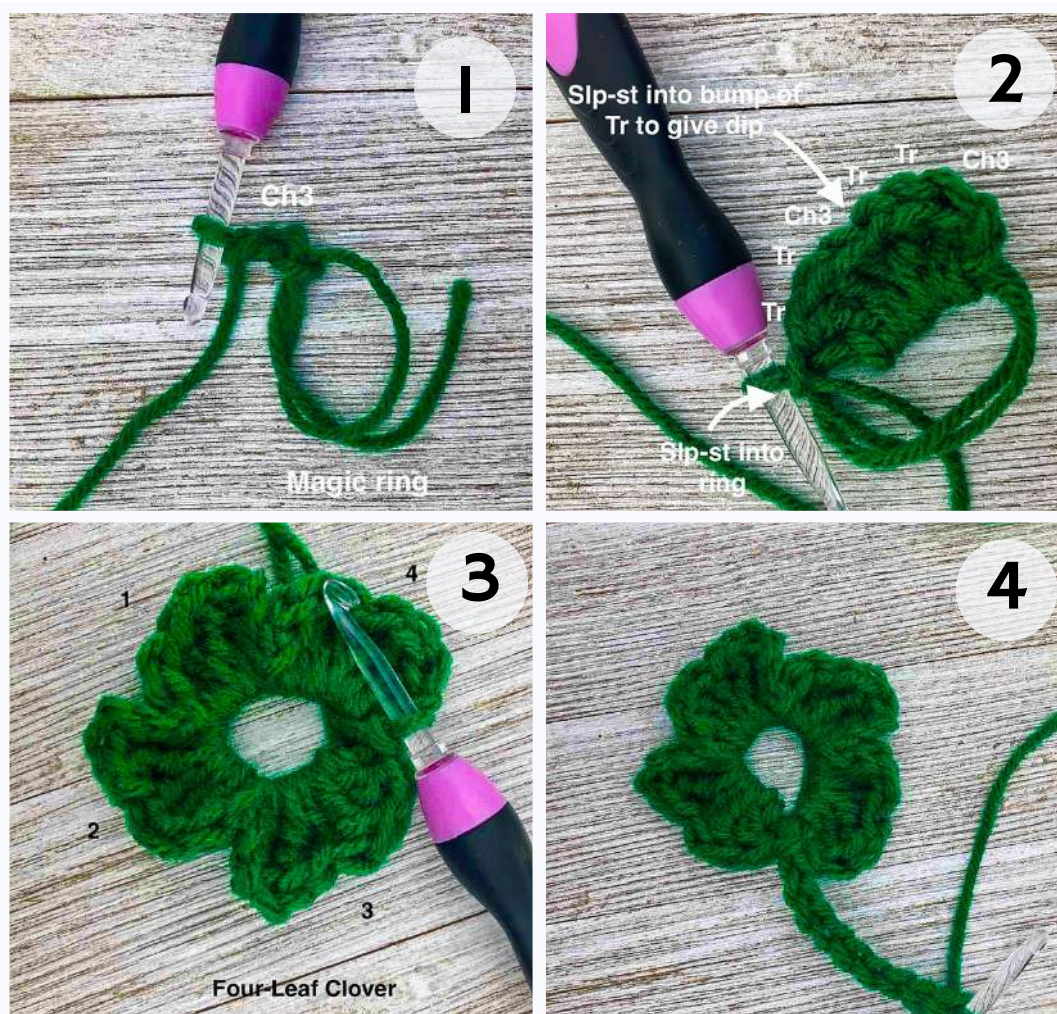
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Construction & Schematics

- This pattern is constructed as one piece with two parts.
- First, the clover leaves are created in the round. **See Images 1 -3.**
- Second, the stem is created flat in rows. **See Image 4.**



SHAMROCK BOOKMARK INSTRUCTIONS



Leaves

See Images 1 - 3 on page 5.

Make a magic ring *Ch 3 (counts as one dc), 2 tr into the ring, slp-st into the little bump on the side of the 2nd tr, ch 3 (counts as one dc), 2 tr into the ring, slp-st into the ring to close*. [6]

You have just created one leaf.

Repeat from * to * two more times to make a 3-leaf clover. [18]

Repeat from * to * three more times to make a 4-leaf clover. [21]

Slip-stitch into the ring to finish off the last leaf.

Do NOT bind off. Continue to Stem Section.

Pro Tip:

Instead of the magic ring, ch 3, slp-st the 1st and last sts together to form a ring.

NOTES:

- Create a large ring if you are doing the 4-leaf clover as it requires more stitches than the 3-leaf clover.
- To find the bump on the 2nd tr, turn your work 90-degrees to the right. There should be two bumps, the top one may be covered by your yarn. You can slp-st into either bump. The top one will give you only a slight dip and the 2nd one will give you a deeper dip.
- If you used the magic ring, be sure to pull the yarn end tight to close up the hole.

Stem

Ch 35.

Bind off and weave in ends.
